

Job Description: Maintenance Technician



Department: Maintenance

Job role overview: Working on rotating shifts within the maintenance team, you will be responsible for completing routine inspections / maintenance and emergency repairs. You will work on various types of machinery including CNC controlled manufacturing equipment, assembly machinery, robotics and site services. You should be comfortable working as part of the Maintenance team or alone as the task dictates. Safety is paramount and taking a proactive approach to risk assessment and mitigation will be key. You will carry out TPMs, small works and general maintenance tasks as required. This position would suit an experienced mechanical or electrical maintenance engineer but ideally someone from a multiskilled background. Equally Machine tool Engineer wishing to move into a static role. The role is very varied and you will be free to use your own initiative and ideas to complete tasks to a high level with autonomy.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Accountable for fault diagnosis and defect rectification on a range of CNC machine tools, robotics, and manual equipment.
- Responding to equipment and machine breakdown and repairing to return to production in a timely manner.
- Seeking long term resolutions to breakdowns to reduce future downtime.
- Repairs to mechanical, electrical, hydraulic, and pneumatic systems.
- Liaising with staff from all departments and at all levels.
- Performing preventative maintenance activities.
- Communicate with other staff on all levels.
- Maintain an inventory of spare parts to minimize downtime including negotiating prices and raising purchase orders.
- Plan and implement modification to new and existing equipment.
- Co-ordinate the installation of new equipment and site services.
- To be proactive in Risk Management strategies.
- Able to work to deadlines.
- To undertake and assist with projects as required by your Manager.
- Any other ad-hoc duties as required by your Manager.
