Job role overview:

Our Group Finance team, based in Hinckley, is responsible for all aspects of finance across our global operations. This includes accounts payable, payroll, customs and duty, management and statutory accounting, treasury and foreign exchange, tax and transfer pricing, commercial finance and business partnering, manufacturing finance, and group consolidation.

This role offers a unique opportunity for an ambitious graduate or early-career finance professional to gain exposure to all major areas of finance within a complex, international business, working in a centralised Group function. The successful candidate will work closely with teams across the finance function and will regularly interact with senior stakeholders, including the CEO and CFO, as well as finance teams around the world.

Initial areas of responsibility will depend on departmental requirements and may vary over time, providing broad experience and a strong foundation for a future career in finance.

This role is demanding and fast-paced, but the scope of learning and development is significant and largely limited only by the individual's ambition and willingness to engage. You will gain a solid grounding in accounting and bookkeeping, contribute to budgeting and forecasting processes, and support a range of projects that deliver real value to the business.

We are looking for highly motivated candidates who are enthusiastic about finance, keen to learn, and eager to make a meaningful contribution to the day-to-day running of the company and to Triumph's future success. Whilst the role is initially on a fixed term basis, you will be ideally placed to capitalise on future full time vacancies that emerge in the wider team.
